**PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER DENYING CHROMADDEX, INC.’S  
*EX PARTE* APPLICATION TO EXCEED THE PAGE LIMIT [Dkt. 221] AND  
DENYING ELYSIUM HEALTH, INC.’S AND MARK MORRIS’S *EX PARTE*  
APPLICATION TO CONSOLIDATE MOTION TO SEAL PROCEDURES  
[Dkt. 223]**

Before the Court are two opposed *ex parte* applications. First, ChromaDex, Inc. requests a ten-page extension of the page limit in support of its motion for summary judgment. (*See* Dkt. 221.) ChromaDex, Inc.’s application is **DENIED**. There is not good cause for a page extension. The legal principles in this case are relatively straightforward to apply. Second, Elysium Health, Inc. and Mark Morris request an order allowing them to consolidate the procedures for motions to seal relating to the parties’ summary judgment motions. (*See* Dkt. 223.) Elysium Health, Inc.’s and Mark Morris’s application is **DENIED**. The procedures under Local Rule 79.-5.2.2 are designed to eliminate or minimize the need for filing under seal. The Court reminds the parties that under seal filings are strongly disfavored, especially in conjunction with dispositive motions.
